

WIND BLOWN SQUARE

Req: Light, medium and dark purple fabrics

Makes 9" unfinished square, 8 1/2" finished.

Cutting Instructions:

Light Fabric - Cut one 5 1/2" square into 4 quarter square triangles - 4 pieces
Cut two 3" squares into half square triangles - 4 pieces total
Cut one 3 1/2" square

Medium Fabric - Cut one 5 1/2" square into quarter square triangles - will use 2 triangles
Cut two 3" squares into half square triangles - 4 pieces total

Dark Fabric - Cut one 5 1/2" square into quarter square triangles - will use 2 triangles
Cut two 3" square into half square triangles - 4 pieces total

Sewing Instructions:

1. Sew 2 of the dark half square triangles to opposite sides of the center light square. See figure one.
2. Sew 2 of the medium half square triangles to other sides of the center light square. See figure one.
3. Sew one short side of a light and dark half square triangle together - twice. See figure two.
4. Sew one short side of a light and one medium half square triangle together - twice keeping light on left as in figure two.
5. Sew 4 pairs of triangles sewn in step 3 and 4 to sides of block. See figure 3. Refer to illustration for color placement.
6. Sew short sides of a light and dark quarter square triangle together - twice.
7. Sew short sides of a light and medium quarter square triangle together - twice.
8. Sew these units to sides of block. Refer to illustration for color placement.

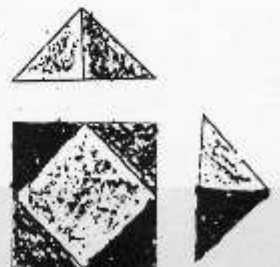
