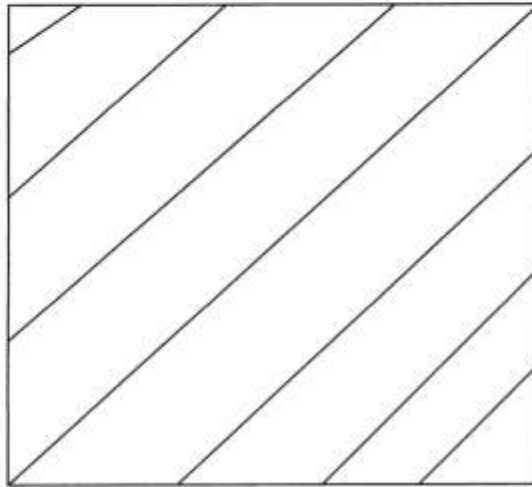

Solid String Piecing

1. Please use solid or Tone on Tone Fabrics, May be Bright, or Muted. **NO PRINTS**
Try not to use strings of fabric wider than $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches, the number of strips will vary depending on the width of fabric

Use $8\frac{1}{4}$ by $8\frac{1}{4}$ inch muslin provided as a base

Begin by placing two strings of fabric right sides together on the diagonal (from corner to corner) and sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam.

Open and Press.

Place another string of fabric on top of the previously sewn strip with the right sides together, sew, open and press. Continue until all the muslin is covered.

Trim to $\frac{1}{8}$ inch beyond the muslin.
