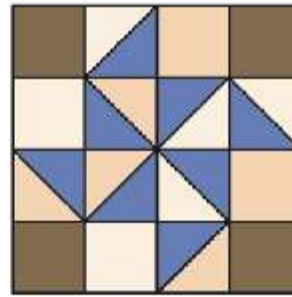


# TWISTER



## BLOCK - X QUARTET

Unfinished size 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### BASICS:

1. Sew using  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Seam allowances are included in all cutting measurements.
2. Press as you go. Press seams in one direction (not open) toward the darker fabric whenever possible.

### MATERIALS

Beiges or tans for background  
Blues for twister  
Browns for corner squares

### CUTTING:

*From background fabric, cut:*

- 4 squares, 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ "
- 4 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "


*From blue fabrics, cut:*

- 4 squares, 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ "

*From brown, cut:*

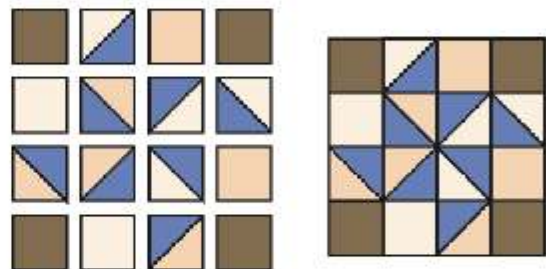
- 2 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Half square triangles
  - a. Draw diagonal line on back side of each background square, 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ ". With right sides together, pair each square with a background square of the same size. 
  - b. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from drawn line on both sides. Cut on drawn line to yield two triangle squares. Press seam toward darker fabric. Make 8.



2. Arrange triangle squares, background squares and brown squares as shown. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
