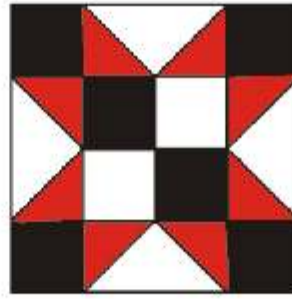


# THE LAST OF THE MOHICANS



## BLOCK - INDIAN STAR

Unfinished size 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### BASICS:

1. Sew using  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Seam allowances are included in all cutting measurements.
2. Press as you go. Press seams in one direction (not open) toward the darker fabric whenever possible.

### MATERIALS

White on white for four patch and flying geese  
Black for four patch and flying geese  
Red for flying geese

### CUTTING:

*From white on white fabric, cut:*

- 2 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 4 rectangles, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

*From black fabric, cut:*

- 6 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

*From red fabric, cut:*

- 8 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Flying Geese
  - a. Draw diagonal line on back side of each red square, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". With right sides together, pair each square with a white rectangle, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", being careful to note direction of drawn line.



- b. Stitch on drawn line. Trim away 2 bottom layers, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press inner corner of square up over stitch line.



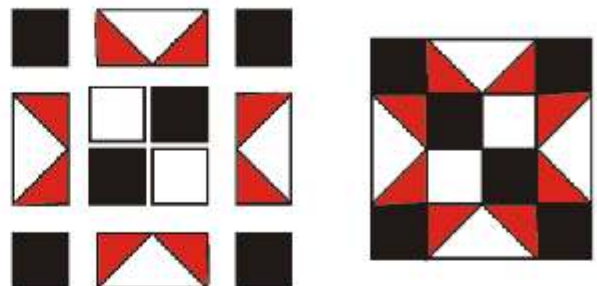
- c. Repeat for opposite side of rectangle.



2. Four patches
  - a. With right sides together, stitch 1 black square, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", to one white on white square of same size. Press toward black square. Make 2.
  - b. Join together to form four patch as shown.



3. Place four patch, flying geese and 4 black squares as shown. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
