
"GONE WITH THE WIND"



BLOCK - PINWHEEL

Unfinished size 121/2" x 121/2"

BASICS:

- Sew using ¹/₄" seams. Seam allowances are included in all cutting measurements.
- Press as you go. Press seams in one direction (not open) toward the darker fabric whenever possible.

MATERIALS

4 "Thirties" fabrics for pinwheels White for background

CUTTING:

From each "thirties" fabric, cut: 2 squares, 37/a" x 37/a"

From background fabric, cut: 8 squares, 37/s" x 37/s"

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

- Half square triangles
 - a. Draw diagonal line on back side of each background square, 3⁷/₈" x 3⁷/₈". With right sides together, pair each square with a "thirties" square of the same size.





b. Stitch ¼" away from drawn line on both sides. Cut on drawn line to yield two triangle squares. Press seam toward darker fabric. Make 4 from each "thirties" fabric.











2. Pinwheel Unit

Arrange 4 triangle squares, rotating as shown. Join to complete one pinwheel. Make four pinwheels in same manner.



Join 4 pinwheels to complete Gone with the Wind block.
