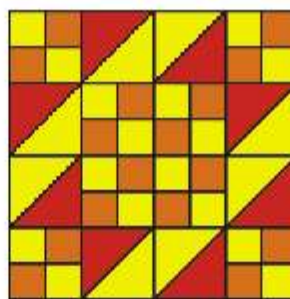


# SUMMER OF '42



## BLOCK - SUNNY LANES

Unfinished size 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### BASICS:

1. Sew using  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Seam allowances are included in all cutting measurements.
2. Press as you go. Press seams in one direction (not open) toward the darker fabric whenever possible.

### MATERIALS

Yellow for four patches and triangle squares  
Orange for four patches  
Red for triangle squares

### CUTTING:

*From yellow fabric, cut:*

4 squares, 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ "

1 strip, 2" x width of fabric

*From orange fabric, cut:*


1 strip, 2" x width of fabric

*From red fabric, cut:*

4 squares, 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ "

## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

### 1. Half square triangles

- a. Draw diagonal line on back side of each yellow square, 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ ". With right sides together, pair each square with a red square of the same size. 
- b. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from drawn line on both sides. Cut on drawn line to yield two triangle squares. Press seam toward red. Make 8.



### 2. Four patches

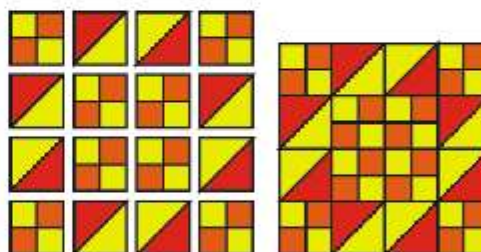
- a. With right sides together, stitch 2" wide yellow strip to 2" wide orange strip. Press toward orange strip. Crosscut into 2" sections.



- b. Join 2 sections together to form four patch as shown. Make 8.



3. Place four patches and triangle squares as shown. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
