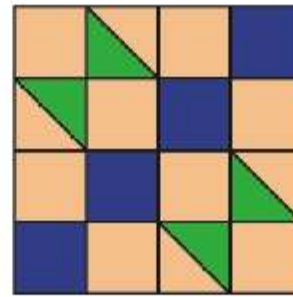


# THE ALAMO



## BLOCK - CROCKETT CABIN

Unfinished size 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

### BASICS:

1. Sew using <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seams. Seam allowances are included in all cutting measurements.
2. Press as you go. Press seams in one direction (not open) toward the darker fabric whenever possible.

### MATERIALS

Tans and beiges for background  
 Dark blue for squares  
 Dark green for triangle squares

### CUTTING:

From tans and beiges for background, cut:

- 2 squares, 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"
- 8 squares, 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

From dark blue fabric, cut:

- 4 squares, 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

From dark green fabric, cut:

- 2 squares, 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"

### BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

#### 1. Half square triangles

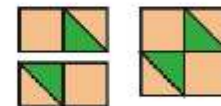
- a. Draw diagonal line on back side of each tan or beige square, 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>". With right sides together, pair each square with a dark green square of the same size.
- b. Stitch <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" away from drawn line on both sides. Cut on drawn line to yield two triangle squares. Press seam toward dark green.



2. Stitch one tan or beige square, 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", to one half square triangle, noting direction of diagonal. Make 4.



3. Stitch two units from step 2 together to make the half square triangle four patch.

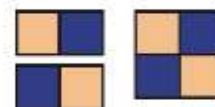


#### 4. Four Patches

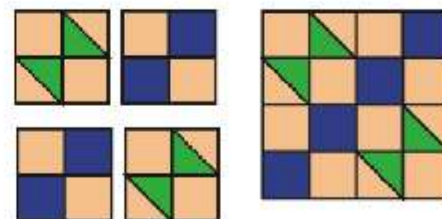
- a. Stitch remaining tan/beige squares to each blue square, 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>".



- b. Join 2 units together to form four patch as shown.



5. Lay four patches out as shown and stitch together to complete block.
