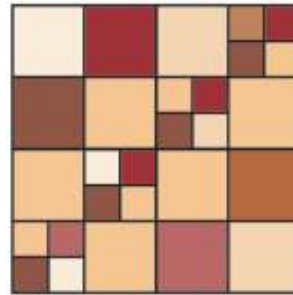


THE CANDIDATE



BLOCK - CARRIE NATION

Unfinished size 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

BASICS:

1. Sew using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Seam allowances are included in all cutting measurements.
2. Press as you go. Press seams in one direction (not open) toward the darker fabric whenever possible.

MATERIALS

Tans and beiges for background
Reds for four patches

CUTTING:

From tans and beiges for background, cut:

- 8 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 8 squares, 2" x 2"

From red fabrics, cut:

- 4 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 8 squares, 2" x 2"

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

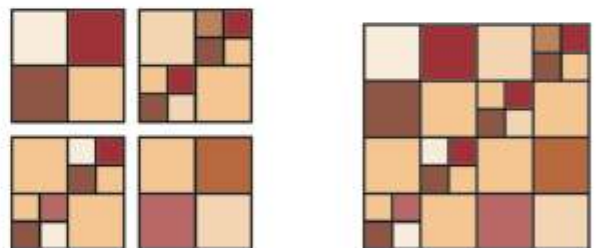
1. Large four patches
 - a. Stitch one background square, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", to red square of same size.
 - b. Join 2 sections together to form four patch as shown. Make 2.



2. Small four patches
 - a. Stitch one background square, 2" x 2", to red square of same size.
 - b. Join 2 sections together to form four patch as shown. Make 4.
3. Double 4 patch
 - a. Stitch one background square, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", to each small four-patch noting direction of red squares. Make 4.
 - b. Rotate unit 180° to make four-patch in a four-patch unit.



4. Arrange four-patches as shown. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
