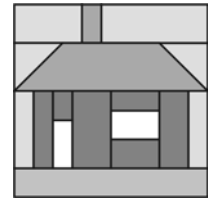


Block #3 - House

Unfinished size 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"



FABRICS

Your choice of colors (who's in the window?)

CUTTING:

From sky fabric, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 2 1/2" x 4" - Sky A
- 1 rectangle, 2 1/2" x 6" - Sky B
- 2 squares, 3" x 3" - Sky C
- 2 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" - Sky D

From roof fabric, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 3" x 10 1/2"

From chimney fabric, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

From wall fabric, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" - Wall E
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 2" - Wall F
- 1 rectangle, 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" - Wall G
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 3" - Wall H
- 1 rectangle, 2" x 3" - Wall J
- 1 rectangle 2" x 4 1/2" - Wall K

From door fabric, cut:

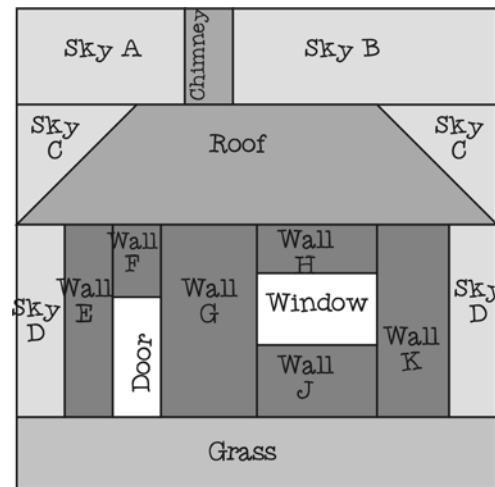
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 3"

From window fabric, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 2" x 3", fussy cut a motif

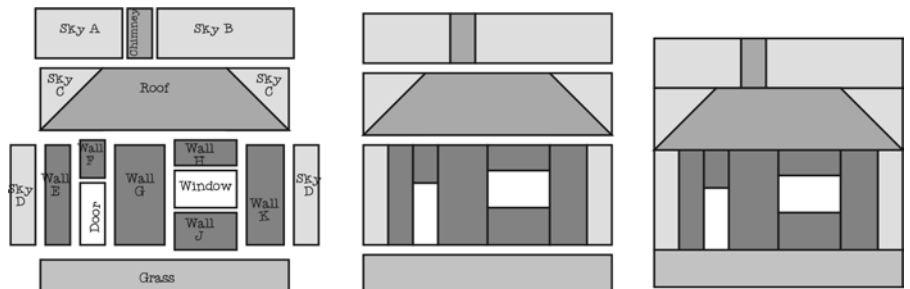
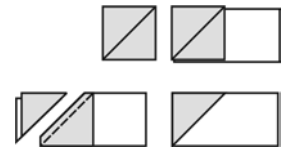
From grass fabric, cut:

- 1 rectangle, 2" x 10 1/2"



BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Roof
 - a. Draw diagonal line on back side of each sky C square, 3" x 3". With right sides together, place square on roof rectangle, noting direction of drawn line. Stitch on drawn line.
 - b. Trim 1/4" from stitched line. Press toward sky.
2. In same manner, add sky fabric square to opposite end of roof fabric rectangle.
3. Arrange pieces as shown.
4. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
