

Block #3 - House

Unfinished size 10¹/₂" x 10¹/₂"

FABRICS

Your choice of colors (who's in the window?)

CUTTING:

From sky fabric, cut:

1 rectangle, 21/2" x 4" - Sky A

1 rectangle, 21/2" x 6" - Sky B

2 squares, 3" x 3" - Sky C

2 rectangles, 11/2" x 41/2" - Sky D

From roof fabric, cut:

1 rectangle, 3" x 10¹/₂"

From chimney fabric, cut:

1 rectangle, 11/2" x 21/2"

From wall fabric, cut:

1 rectangle, $1^{1}/_{2}$ " x $4^{1}/_{2}$ " - Wall E

1 rectangle, 11/2" x 2" - Wall F

1 rectangle, 21/2" x 41/2" - Wall G

1 rectangle, 11/2" x 3" - Wall H

1 rectangle, 2" x 3" - Wall J

1 rectangle 2" x 41/2" - Wall K

From door fabric, cut:

`1 rectangle, 1¹/₂" x 3"

From window fabric, cut:

1 rectangle, 2" x 3", fussy cut a motif

From grass fabric, cut:


1 rectangle, 2" x 10¹/₂"




BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Roof
 - a. Draw diagonal line on back side of each sky C square, 3" x 3". With right sides together, place square on roof rectangle, noting direction of drawn line. Stitch on drawn line.
 - b. Trim ¹/₄" from stitched line. Press toward sky.
- 2. In same manner, add sky fabric square to opposite end of roof fabric rectangle.
- 3. Arrange pieces as shown.
- 4. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
