


Block #7 - Snowman

Unfinished size 6¹/₂" x 6¹/₂"



FABRICS

Blue background Cream or white face Black or navy top hat

CUTTING:

From background fabric, cut:

- 2 rectangles, 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂", for piece A
- 2 rectangles, $1^{1}/_{2}$ " x $3^{1}/_{2}$ ", for piece B
- 2 squares, 1¹/₂" x 1¹/₂", for piece C


From face fabric, cut: 1 rectangle, 3¹/₂" x 4¹/₂", for piece F

From hat fabric, cut:


1 rectangle, $1^{1}/_{2}$ " x $6^{1}/_{2}$ ", for piece E 1 rectangle, $2^{1}/_{2}$ " x $4^{1}/_{2}$ ", for piece D

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Face
 - a. Draw a diagonal line on back side of small background fabric square. With right sides together, place square on face rectangle, noting direction of drawn line. Stitch on drawn line.



- b. Trim ¹/₄" from stitched line. Press toward background.
- c. In same manner, add background fabric square to opposite corner of face rectangle.
- 2. Arrange background pieces, hat pieces and face unit as shown.
- 3. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.



4, Use beads, buttons, applique, embroidery, felt scraps or anything else you choose to embellish his eyes, nose, mouth and hat.

For Block Party Quilt, make 1.
