

## Block \#1- Sailboat

Unfinished size $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$


## FABRICS

Your choice of colors for boat and sails (sails can match or compliment)
Sky blue for upper background
Watery blue for lower background

## CUTTING:

From sky blue fabric, cut:
1 square, $4^{1 / 21} \times 4^{11 / 2 "}$
1 rectangle, $2^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 4^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$
From main sail fabric, cut:
1 square, $4^{1 ⁄ 2 "} \times 41122^{\prime \prime}$
From small sail fabric, cut:
2 square, $2^{1 ⁄ 2 " ~} \times 2^{11 / 2 "}$
From boat fabric, cut:
' 1 rectangle $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ "
From water fabric, cut:
2 squares, $2^{1 / 1 / 2 " ~ x ~} 2^{11 / 2 "}$

## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Main sail
a. Draw diagonal line on back side of sky blue square, $4^{7 / 8 "} \times 4^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$. With right sides together, pair square with main sail square of the same size.
b. Stitch on drawn line. Cut $1 / 4$ " away from drawn line. Press seam toward dark.

2. Small sail
a. Draw a diagonal line on back side of small sail fabric square. With right sides together, place square on sky blue background rectangle, noting direction of drawn line. Stitch on drawn line.
b. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from stitched line. Press toward small sail.

3. In same manner, add water fabric squares to each end of boat fabric rectangle.

4. Arrange main sail, small sail and boat units as shown.
5. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
