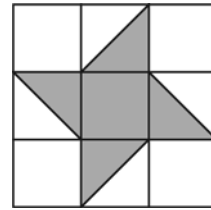


Block #1 - Friendship Star



Unfinished size $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$

FABRICS

Red, white and blue - Patriotic fabrics

1 light

1 dark

CUTTING:

From light fabric, cut:

2 squares, $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$

4 squares, $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

From dark fabric, cut:

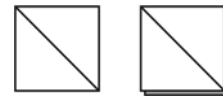
1 square, $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

2 squares, $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Half square triangles

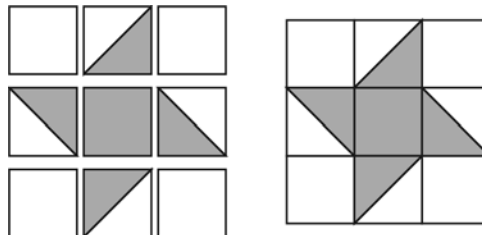
a. Draw diagonal line on back side of light square, $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$.
With right sides together, pair each square with a dark square of the same size.



b. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}''$ away from drawn line on both sides. Cut on drawn line to yield two triangle squares. Press seam toward dark.



2. Arrange half square triangles, dark square and 4 light squares as shown.



3. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.

Note: If making the Block Party Quilt for yourself, make 4 blocks.
