


Block #10 - Tulip

Unfinished size 61/2" x 61/2"



FABRICS

White, beige or neutral for background Yellow for flower center Pastels for flower petals Green for leaves

CUTTING:

From white, beige or neutral fabric, cut:

3 squares, 21/2" x 21/2"

2 squares, 27/8" x 27/8"

1 rectangle, 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂"

1 square, 11/2" x 11/2"

From yellow fabric, cut:

1 square, 1¹/₂" x 1¹/₂"

From pastel fabric, cut:

1 square, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂"


1 square, 27/8" x 27/8"

From green fabric, cut:


1 square, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈"

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Half square triangles
 - a. Draw diagonal line on back side of 1 background square, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈". With right sides ↓ together, pair square with a flower petal square of the same size.
- - b. Stitch 1/4" away from drawn line on both sides. Cut on drawn line to yield two triangle squares. Press seam toward flower petal fabric.
 - c. In same manner, make 2 background/leaf half square triangles using 1 background square $2^{7}/8$ " x $2^{7}/8$ ", and one leaf fabric square of the same size.
- 2. Bud unit
 - a. With right sides together, stitch 1½" yellow bud square to same size background square.



3. Arrange half square triangles, bud unit, background and petal squares as shown. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
