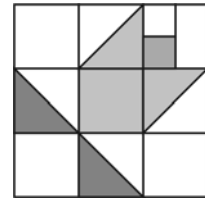


# Block #10 - Tulip

Unfinished size 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"



## FABRICS

White, beige or neutral for background  
 Yellow for flower center  
 Pastels for flower petals  
 Green for leaves

## CUTTING:

*From white, beige or neutral fabric, cut:*

- 3 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 2 squares, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"
- 1 rectangle, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 1 square, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

*From yellow fabric, cut:*

- 1 square, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

*From pastel fabric, cut:*



- 1 square, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 1 square, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

*From green fabric, cut:*



- 1 square, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

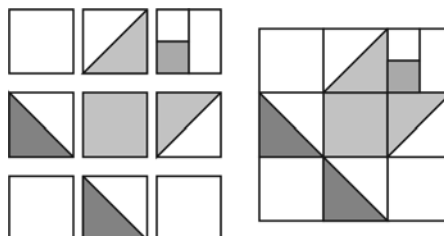
### 1. Half square triangles

- a. Draw diagonal line on back side of 1 background square, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8". With right sides together, pair square with a flower petal square of the same size. 
- b. Stitch 1/4" away from drawn line on both sides. Cut on drawn line to yield two triangle squares. Press seam toward flower petal fabric.
- c. In same manner, make 2 background/leaf half square triangles using 1 background square 2 7/8" x 2 7/8", and one leaf fabric square of the same size. 

### 2. Bud unit

- a. With right sides together, stitch 1 1/2" yellow bud square to same size background square. 
- b. Stitch background rectangle, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2", to one side to complete bud unit as shown. 

### 3. Arrange half square triangles, bud unit, background and petal squares as shown. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.
