

## Block \#12 - Bowtie

Unfinished size $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$


## FABRICS

White, beige or neutral for background Masculine colors for bowties

## CUTTING:

From white, beige or neutral fabric, cut:
2 squares, $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 3^{1 / 2 "}$
From bowtie fabric, cut:
2 squares, $3^{1 ⁄ 1 / 2 " ~ x ~} 3^{11 ⁄ 2 "}$
2 squares, 2" x 2 "

## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Draw diagonal line on back side of each bowtie square, $2 " \times 2$ ". Place background square on one corner of background fabric square, $3^{11 / 2 "} \times 3^{11 / 2 "}$ noting direction of drawn line.

2. Stitch on drawn line. Trim 2 bottom layers leaving a ${ }^{1 / 4 "}$ seam allowance.
3. Arrange block pieces as shown. Stitch into rows, then join rows to complete block.


For Block Party Quilt, make 1.
