

## Block \#4 - Pumpkin

Unfinished size $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 6{ }^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## FABRICS

Pumpkin - orange scraps
Background - neutral - white, beige, pale blue
Stem - green

## CUTTING:



From pumpkin fabrics, cut:
2 rectangles, $4^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 6 " ~-~ u n i t ~ A, ~ p i e c e s ~} 1 \& 8$
1 rectangle, $3 " \times 6 "$ - unit A, piece 2
2 rectangles, $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ - unit A, pieces 3 \& 5
2 rectangles, $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ - unit A, pieces $4 \& 9$
1 rectangle, $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 3^{1 / 2 "}$, unit A, piece 7
From stem fabric, cut:
1 rectangle, $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ - unit B, piece 2
From background fabric, cut:
2 rectangles, $3^{1 / 21} \times 4^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ - unit B, pieces $3 \& 4$
4 rectangles, $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}-$ unit A, pieces $5,6,10,11$
1 rectangle, $1^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - unit B, piece 1


## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. Place unit $A$, piece 1 right side up on the wrong side of the paper pattern (so that wrong side of fabric touches wrong side of paper). Hold up to a bright light to be sure that piece 1 on the paper is completely covered by fabric. If desired, hold in place with a pin. Align piece 2 to piece 1, right sides together. Piece 2 should lay about $1 / 4$ " over sewing line. Set machine on very small stitches to aid in paper removal, and stitch along the line between piece 1 and piece 2 . The lined side of the paper will be facing up and the fabric will be against the throatplate as you sew. Start a feqw stitches before line begins and end a few stitches after line ends. Flip piece 2 to ensure pattern is covered, then trim seam close to stitching. Press seam toward Piece 2. In same manner, attach piece 3 to piece 2. Continue working in numerical order until unit A is complete.
2. In same manner, construct unit $B$.
3. Sew units $A \& B$ together. When block is complete, stitch within seam allowance and trim paper-side up, being sure you leave a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance along outside lines. Leave paper on.

If making Block Party Quilt for yourself, make 1 block.
