

Background – Cream: Cut 1 template "B" and 1 reversed template "B". Cut 2 @ $6\frac{1}{2}$ x $6\frac{1}{2}$; with right sides together, place a dot $2\frac{1}{2}$ " from the left at the top; draw a diagonal line from this dot to the other lower right corner, and cut on this line. See diagram "C". These 2 will be sewn to the cone.

Ice cream scoop: any color! Cut 1 template "A" and 1 reversed "A". Pin the edges and center (and more if needed) of "A" to "B" at the curve; sew, being careful not to stretch the fabric as you sew. Go slow and you can do these curves! Press. Sew these 2 units together; press.

Ice cream cone: 1 @ $6\frac{1}{2}$ x $5\frac{1}{2}$; fold the $6\frac{1}{2}$ in half as shown, diagram "D"; it will measure $3\frac{1}{4}$ x $5\frac{1}{2}$. Cut diagonally from one corner to the opposite corner. Unfold and this is your cone! Sew cone to backing, starting at cone top for both sides; the bottom edges will not match; press. Sew your ice cream scoop to your cone, matching the centers. Note that the edges of the ice cream overflow your cone, as in real life! Press. Cut block to $10\frac{1}{2}$ x $10\frac{1}{2}$.
