

## **BLOCK OF THE MONTH - JANUARY: "Jar of Sweets" - Dayna Ragland**

Background (cream):

A - 2 @  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$

B - 2 @  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$

C - 2 @  $2 \times 7\frac{1}{2}$

D - 4 @  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$

Jar Lid: E - 1 @  $4\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$

Jar Contents: F - 1 @  $7\frac{1}{2} \times 7\frac{1}{2}$

May be a jar of cookies, candy, jelly beans, jelly, jam, honey, donuts, peppermints, etc.

Sewing instructions:

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner on the back of each of the D squares. Place each on a corner of the F square and sew on the drawn lines. Trim and press. Sew C to the sides of F. Sew B to the sides of E. Press. Sew all together as shown, below, and press.
