

Background - cream:

A - cut one square $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X $1\frac{1}{2}$ " , draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of fabric

B - cut two rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

C - cut two rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $10\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cake layers - (choose your "flavor"):

D - cut two rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

Icing - (choose your "flavor"):

E - cut two rectangles $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X $5\frac{1}{2}$ "

F - cut one rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Directions for sewing: Lay the A square at one end of the F rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line to form the A/F piece. Press open and trim the excess cream fabric from the back. Sew the Ds to the Es and then sew together to form the cake/icing layers. Sew the A/F piece to the layered piece. Sew the B pieces to the sides and then the C pieces to the top and bottoms. Unfinished size should be $10\frac{1}{2}$ " X $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".
