

Cutting Instructions

From White on White (Background)

- 2—2.5" x 6" (A)
- 4—1.5" x 1.5" (C)
- 1—5" x 5" (D Unit)
- 1—4" x 2.5" (H)
- 1—6" x 4.5" (I)
- 1—6" x 6.5" (K)

From Handle Fabric

- 2—1.5" x 1.5" (B)
- 1—1.5" x 2.5" (G)
- 1—1.5" x 6.5" (J)

From main umbrella fabric

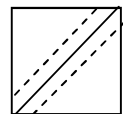
- 1—4.5" x 2" (F)
- 1—5" x 5" (D Unit)

From umbrella stripe

- 2—1.75" x 4.5" (E)

Piecing Instructions

To make the D Unit: Place the 2 5" x 5" pieces right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the white on white and sew 1/4" away from the line on both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the line. Press to the dark fabric. Trim this piece to 4.5" x 4.5".



To make the Curved Handle:

Place a 1.5" x 1.5" square on the end of piece J right sides together. Sew diagonally down the center of the white. Press open, cut away excess fabric. Repeat for piece G but in the opposite direction.



Assemble the block as shown in the diagram. Press all seams to the darkest fabric.

Finished size for the block is 12.5" x 12.5" .

Optional Embellishments Ideas: Add a button for the top of the parasol. Add beading or fringe for the bottom of the parasol.
