July 8th: Laying out a quilt, sewing a quilt top, borders

August 12th: Quilting a quilt, prepping a quilt for a professional quilter, binding, labels, quilt care

- Scissors
- Straight Pins
- Pin Cushion
- Sewing Machine Needles
- Seam Ripper
- Cotton Thread
- Safety Pins
- Quarter Inch Foot
- Walking Foot (for straight-line quilting)
